Rule #5

Board Membership Rotation

Approved by the CEC Board of Direction: 01 August 2022¹

Rule applicability: CEC Board

The CEC bylaws prescribe a rotating membership representing CEC Administrative Units and ASCE Institutes. To provide representation as the number of administrative units change, and recognizing potential variability in Institute engagement, the following rotation is applicable.

Administrative Units

Administrative units hold 3 board seats rotated among active units listed in CEC Rule #1. When a seat becomes available, the next administrative unit, in order of inception as listed in Rule 1, may nominate a board candidate subject to approval by the CEC board. If the eligible unit does not make a nomination, the next administrative unit becomes eligible for a nomination.

Institutes

Institutes hold 2 board seats rotated among the ASCE Institutes, regardless of whether they have a parallel administrative unit. When a seat becomes available, the next Institute, in alphabetical order, may nominate a board candidate subject to approval by the CEC board. If the eligible Institute does not make a nomination, the next Institute becomes eligible for a nomination.

¹ Rule is effective when the ASCE Board of Direction approves revised CEC bylaws.
